

Player and Parent Code of Conduct Contract
Willard Youth Wrestling

As a wrestler of Willard Youth Wrestling:

- ✧ I, as a wrestler, will use every effort to be a positive member of my club and exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
- ✧ I will keep in mind that this is an extra-curricular activity and will keep my grades and behavior at an appropriate level so that I may participate.
- ✧ I will attempt to attend and actively participate in every practice and event that I attend
- ✧ I will practice and wrestle to the best of my ability.
- ✧ I recognize that even though this is an individual sport, that I am representing Willard Youth Wrestling; as such the interests of the club shall take precedence over individual exploits.
- ✧ I will not criticize the performance of another wrestler, a coach's decision, a referee's call or an opponent.
- ✧ I will conduct myself in a respectable manner at practices and at tournaments/duals.
- ✧ I will not attempt ever to deliberately injure/hurt another wrestler.
- ✧ Always shake opponents hand-WIN OR LOSE

For the Parents of Willard Youth Wrestling:

- ✧ Provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child's participation in youth sports by following this code of ethics.
- ✧ I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all wrestlers, coaches and officials at every practice and tournaments. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- ✧ I will insist that my child wrestle in a safe and healthy environment.
- ✧ I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- ✧ I will ask my child to treat other wrestlers, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- ✧ I will make every effort for my child to attend all practices and tournaments that I agree to attend and I will give proper notification to the coach if they are unable to attend.
- ✧ I will see that all the requested fees are paid in full before my child participates.
- ✧ NO PARENT ALLOWED MATSIDE. If this should occur the President of WYW will address the parent and they may be asked to leave the gym.
- ✧ ALL PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO WORK ALL DAY OF THE TOURNAMENTS. This includes (not limited to) set up-clean up. The afternoon session parents must assist with clean up. Set up is done the night before but some early morning responsibilities are required.

I realize that failure to comply with the above regulations may result in loss of practice time or suspension from a tournament.
