- W Provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child's participation in youth sports by following this code of ethics.
- W I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all wrestlers, coaches and officials at every practice and tournaments. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- W I will insist that my child wrestle in a safe and healthy environment.
- ₩ I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- W I will ask my child to treat other wrestlers, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- W I will make every effort for my child to attend all practices and tournaments that I agree to attend and I will give proper notification to the coach if they are unable to attend.
- W I will see that all the requested fees are paid in full before my child participates.
- W NO PARENT ALLOWED MATSIDE. If this should occur the President of WYW will address the parent and they may be asked to leave the gym.
- W ALL PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO WORK ALL DAY OF THE TOURNAMENTS. This includes (not limited to) set up-clean up. The afternoon session parents must assist with clean up. Set up is done the night before but some early morning responsibilities are required.
